The Elkhart Historical Society is delighted to announce its April events, starting with the much anticipated Wildflower Nature Walks, each Saturday in April. (1st, 8th, 15th, 22nd and 29th) by reservation only. It is exciting to see the progression of the various flowering species as spring casts off the winter drabs and comes alive again.

The final day, April 29th, is a combination wildflower and bird event celebrating the returning birds as they migrate thru the flowering woodlands on Elkhart Hill. We will be joined by three premiere birders, Dr. Lara Borgerson, Joe Funk, and Rhetta Jack, at both 6a and 4p for the segments that are, "For the Birds" and also join the Flower and Bird walks at 10a and 2p

The spring ephemeral bloom time is short, and space is limited, so get your reservations in as soon as possible. Private tours can be arranged for groups of 10 or more on April Wednesdays-Fridays, with an optional lunch at Horsefeather's Wild Hare Café if desired. The cost of the walk is \$15 per adult and \$10 for children ages 8-12; and lunch is \$10 for adults and \$5 for children. All reservations must be made by calling 217.947.2238.
